
## The Water Cycle



## Down:

- 1. Body of salt water that nearly covers 3/4 of the earth's surface.
- 2. Water that is trapped underground.
- 4. Partially frozen snow.
- 6. A small body of running water.
- 7. Mass of water vapor floating in the air above the earth's surface.
- 8. Occurs when water vapor changes to water droplets.
- 9. Small, usually round pieces of ice that fall from the sky.
- 10. Occurs when a cloud of very small water droplets in the air form close to the earth's surface.

## Across:

- 3. Large bodies of water surrounded by land.
- 5. Moving water that empties into a lake, river, or ocean.
- 11. Made up of drops of water.
- 12. A change from liquid to vapor.
- 13. Any form of water that falls to the earth such as rain, hail, or snow.
- 14. Made up of hydrogen and oxygen.
