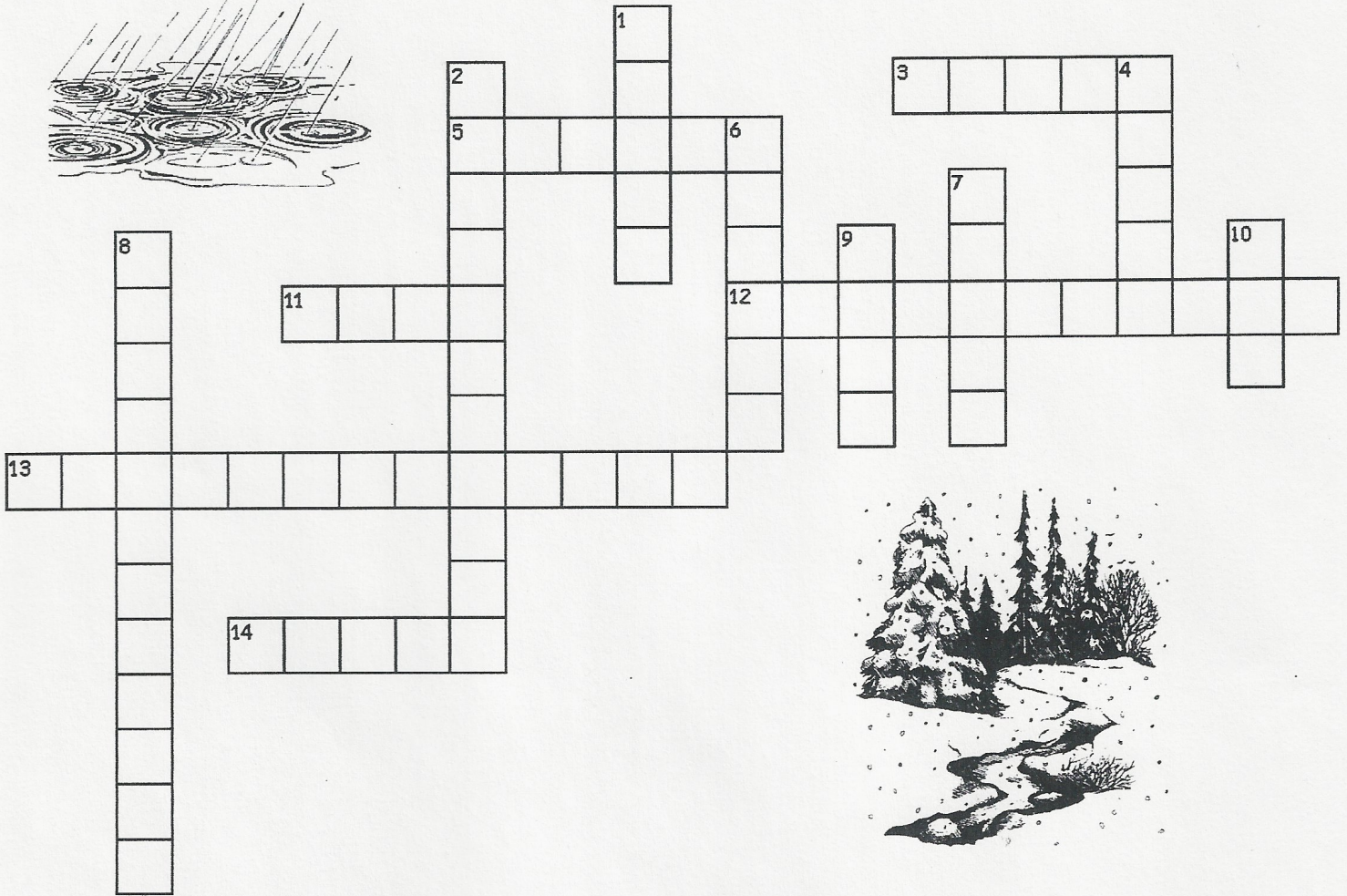
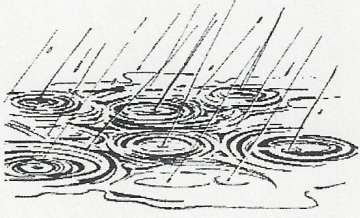


The Water Cycle



Down:

1. Body of salt water that nearly covers 3/4 of the earth's surface.
2. Water that is trapped underground.
4. Partially frozen snow.
6. A small body of running water.
7. Mass of water vapor floating in the air above the earth's surface.
8. Occurs when water vapor changes to water droplets.
9. Small, usually round pieces of ice that fall from the sky.
10. Occurs when a cloud of very small water droplets in the air form close to the earth's surface.

Across:

3. Large bodies of water surrounded by land.
5. Moving water that empties into a lake, river, or ocean.
11. Made up of drops of water.
12. A change from liquid to vapor.
13. Any form of water that falls to the earth such as rain, hail, or snow.
14. Made up of hydrogen and oxygen.
